**Ealdormere Internal Letter Of Intent
Comments from February 18, 2003 Meeting**

Greetings unto College of Heraldry and the members of the populace does THLady Arwyn of Leicester, THLord Erick of Longacres, Lord Percival de la Rocque and Lord Nele ap Llewellyn give warm greetings. Here are the comments from our meeting.

1. Aodhan Longshafts (Name ELOI Jan 03, Kingdom Resubmission-Device)
Per embattled line, Azure and Gules, Sheaf of three broad arrows inverted Argent, Bordure Argent

A better blazon would be Per fess embattled, azure and gules, sheaf of three broad arrows inverted, a bordure argent.

No obvious conflicts found. We agree with the new blazon. The new submission is better than the previous. Device is to be passed to Laurel.

2. Conrad Waffenschmied (New Name)
Conrad – 1281, 1289, etc from St. Gabriel site (s-gabriel.org/names/talan/bahlowMasc.html)
Dated 05/11/02. Talan's article on Medieval German Given Names from Silesia: Men's Names (copies provided)
Waffenschmied –Langenscheidt's Concise German Dictionary (copies provided)
-means armorer (no date given)
-submitter will accept minor changes, and care more about being German but would like it to be 13th C male name.
The Ealdormerian commenters feel that the by-name of armourer may or may not be acceptable for the time and period. We will pass up to Laurel to decide.

3. Eadwine of Foxecote (Name ELOI Nov 02, Kingdom Resubmission-Badge)
Gules, a foxes mask Argent within a bordure sable fimbriated argent.
The fimbriated is too wide and conflict with RfS VIII.3. Suggest the following: Argent, a foxes mask gules and an orle sable. Fieldless, a foxes mask argent charged with a annulet sable.
Badge to be returned for further work.

4. Jean de Beauvoir (Middle –Mar 93) (New Device)
Per saltire argent semie de-lys sable and azure.
This is field primary armoury as per RfS X.4.ii as appears to be clear of conflicts. We send this to Laurel

5. Johan de Foderingeye (Jun-02) (New Device)
Per pale Argent and Azure, a branch of oak, countercharged.
A better blazon would be Per pale, Argent and Azure, a branch of oak, counterchanged.

No conflicts. Pass up to Laurel.

6. Kilian von Würzburg (New Name and Device)
Gyronny Azure and Or, a mullet of eight points counterchanged
Killian –8th C, Academy of St. Gabriel Report 337 (www.panix.com/~gabriel/public-bin/showfinal.cgi?337+0) dated 09/09/2001
-copies provided
Late period German Masculine Given Names (www.s-gabriel.org/names/talan/germmasc/plauen16.htm)
-14th-15th C
-first bishop of Würzburg 743 in www.newadvent.org/cathen/0839a.htm)
-no changes allowed.
Presumptuous RfS VI.4 He was a real person. Removing one “l” does not make it clear. Lack of name to submit with requires the return device. It appears to be clear. Please use the Crayola markers for the device.

7. Lachlan MacLean (New Name and Device)
Azure, an orle Or, Six Daggers proper conjoined at the hilts.
Not sure of blazon. Is there a “proper” dagger?
Pended next meeting name documentation.
Device appears to be Ok.
