**Ealdormere Commentary on Letter Of Intent

Greetings unto the College of Heraldry and the People of Ealdormere. Here is the commentary on the Internal Letter of Intent for April 2003. In attendance at the consultation meeting held on the 19th of April 2003 at Bards Birthday Bash were, Arwyn Trillium Herald, Eric of Long Acres (Incoming Trillium) Percival Green Mantle Herald, Nele Seeblatt Herald, Edmund Stave Pursuivant, Evelyn ate Hoyle Ashford upon Avon Pursuivant, Ludvik Tschelln and Muireen ingen Morgair.

**Please note that this letter and the March ILoI have been combined into one external letter of intent to be forwarded to the Laurel King of Arms.

1. Alistair Kirk (Name May-83, Device Change)

Quarterly argent and ermine azure and Or, in bend sinister two compass stars all within a bordure azure

-he wishes to retain his current device:

Quarterly ermine and Or, a raven volant sable between in bend sinister two compass stars, all within a bordure azure as a badge.

Suggested new blazon should be Quarterly ermine and Or, in bend sinister two compass stars all within a bordure azure.

*The only conflict that could be found for this device was the submitters own device that is being changed to a badge should this submission be registered. We have passed this up to Laurel to decide.

2. Auguste Valason (Name Kingdom Resubmission, New Badge)

Argent, a trillium gules seeded and barbed vert within a bordure dancetty gules.

-Auguste –pg 16 Dictionnaire Etymologique des Noms de Famille et Pronoms de France, Par Albert Dauzat.

-no dates given on the copies sent to the Seeblatt. Does the original submission have the copies to indicate date

-Vali –pg 15 The Old Norse Name, Geirr Bassi Haraldsson. I-A to allow Valason as per pg 17. Use the patronymic of Vali to Valason

-again, does the original submission have the copies with dates? Please advise.

-desired gender male, will accept minor changes but care more about sound

*No conflict could be found and the only negative commentary was based on combination of Old Norse and French names. However we have determined that this is only one weirdness and as such should be registerable. We have passed it up to Laurel. The Badge also does not

appear to conflict and we have passed this to Laurel .

3. Gina il Castello del Drago (Name ELOI Nov-02, Device Kingdom Resubmission)

Or, a visored helm crested with a dragon statant purpure.

-resubmission has been drawn with the dragon smaller in comparison to helm.

*While we still found the drawings to be somewhat less than perfect we felt this should not cause problems at laurel level. The blazon is not totally accurate but this is not what is being passed so we will Pass on to Laurel and let them re blazon as needed.

4. Jared Edwardson (New Name, New Device)

Argent, a bat azure within a bordure quarter azure and sable.

-Jared –given name with attached photocopy of birth certificate

-Edwardson –Reaney & Wilson, Revised Edition 1997, Pg 52.

-desired gender male

*No name conflict found and documentation is in order and satisfactory to Pass on to Laurel. The device does not appear to conflict and is Passed up to Laurel.

5. Michelina D'Este (New Name)

-Michelina of Pesaro –1300 Italy

-patron saint index

*No conflict was found. We do feel the documentation was a little on the weak side but

we could see no good reason not to Pass this up to Laurel.

6. Richard of Dragon Castle (Name ELOI Nov 02, Device Kingdom Resubmission)

Purpure, a lion rampant maintaining an egg Or, a bordure Or, semy fleur de lis purpure

Suggested new blazon,

Purpure, a lion rampant maintaining an egg, on a bordure Or, a semy of fleur de lis purpure.

-submitter has removed the problems with the bezants from prior submission

*The changes made have cleared up all the problems we could see on the original and this device will be Passed up to Laurel.

7. Séamus mac Dubhgaill ó Ólchobhair (New Name, New Device)

Per saltire, argent and Or, on a gouté de sang a goblet argent

-submitter will not accept major changes, desired it to be male, 13th Century Irish

- Séamus – pg 163 Irish Names, Donnchedh Ó Corrain, Fidelma Maguire
- mac –“son of”
- Dubhgaill pg 79, 163 Irish Names, Donnchedh Ó Corrain, Fidelma Maguire
- ó Ólchobhair pg 149, 163 Irish Names, Donnchedh Ó Corrain, Fidelma Maguire

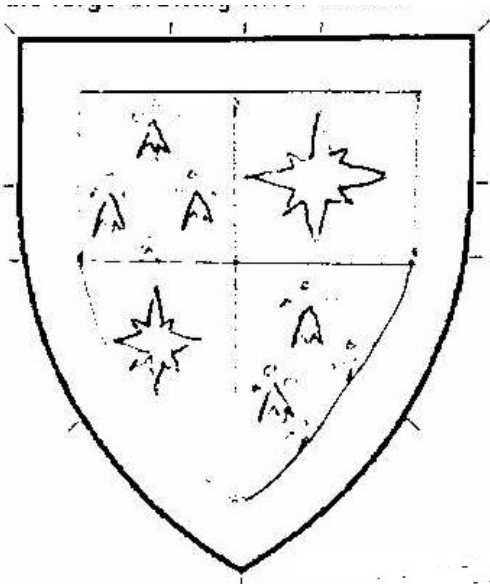
Does the original submission have the copies to indicate the date?

Suggested new blazon Per saltire, argent and Or, on a gouté gules, a goblet argent

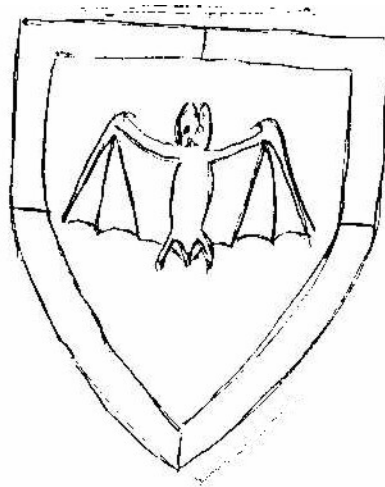
-goblet has been drawn in three dimensions.

*No conflict was found on the name. However the documentation while form good sources does not summarise the dates this name was found to be used in period. Return for better documentation. The Device also conflicts directly with “An Tir Kingdom of registered in 03 1983. Checky Or and argent a goutte de sang.” This has only a minor change for the field arraignment and one cd for the charged Goutte. Also conflicts with Cindy of Angles registered in 03 2000. Per saltier argent and azure a goutte within a bordure gules. Return for conflict.

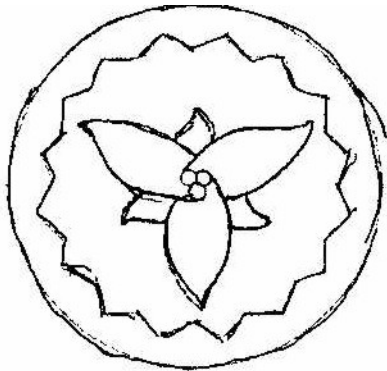

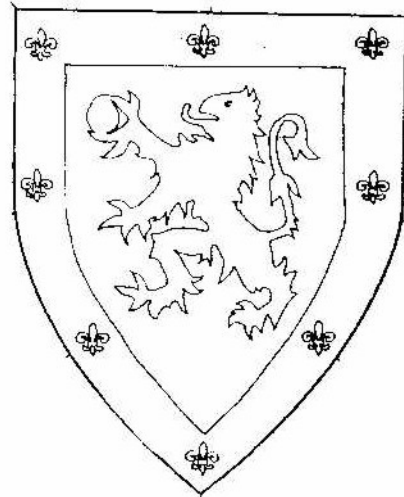

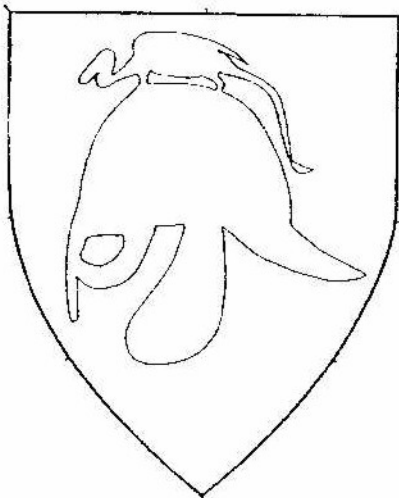
