Ealdormere Letter Of Intent

Unto the good people of the Kingdom of Ealdormere from Percival de la Rocque, Green Mantle Herald, Nele Ap Llewellyn, Seeblatt Herald and the Ealdormere College of heralds. Greetings good gentles and good wishes unto you all. The following are the results of the commentary meeting of the College of Heraldry on the May Internal Letter of Intent. The meeting was held on Saturday May 17th A.S. XXXVIII at Ragnarok in the Barony of Ramshaven. Present at the meeting were, Percival de la Rocque Green Mantle Herald, Nele ap Llewellyn Seeblatt Herald, Liadin de Teach Càirdeas Buccina Herald and Wencenoel of Rokesburg Pursuivant at Large.

1. Auguste Valisan (new device submission, Name submitted LOI 01/03)

Argent a peacock in its pride azure collared by a baronial coronet argent within two barrulets between two teapots vert.

Documentation supporting the submitters use of the coronet are attached, the submitter is a Court Baron awarded 29 May 2000 in Ealdormere. Also attached is a document to support the use of the teapot as this is believed to be the first such item registered in the society. A synopsis of this documentation shows the teapot coming to Europe from China in the first half of the 16th Century and examples from Syria around the 10th century.

No conflict could be found and based on the provided documentation we have passed this device up to Laurel.

2. Eyrny Ormarrsdottir (new Device submission, Name registered 02/92 Middle)

Or a lozenge and a bordure purple.

A very nice and simple device that is in the spirit of period heraldry in every way. No conflict came to our attention and we have passed this device up to Laurel.

3. James Erec of York (Device Change, name registered 11/92 Middle)

Gules, semi of roses Or, a sea dog rampant argent.

Release old device if registered.

Awesome looking Heraldry and clear of any conflict. This too has been passed on to Laurel.

4. Marioun Gologhtly (Device Submission, Name submitted 03/2003).

Barry Or and azure, on a bend sinister sable three escallops argent..

This was a resubmission at the Kingdom level for a conflict and the re-design has cleared this problem up and no conflict came to our attention. Another nice and very period looking device and will be passed up to Laurel.

5. porfinna gra'feldr [Thorfinna gra'feldr] (Name and Device resubmission /see LoAR Oct./2002)

Argent three serpents nowed gules.

Porfinna/Thorfinna- Geirr Bassi (Old Norse Names P-16)
gra'feldr- Geirr Bassi (Old Norse Names P-22 meaning gray fur coat or cloak.

Submitter wishes a Feminine name authentic for 11th century Norse and cares most about language/culture. Will also accept any changes or a holding name.

Once again this was a resubmission this time from the Laurel level. The minor change to the name submission clears up the previous problem and no conflict could be found. Name passed on to Laurel. Likewise the device shows no conflicts and will be passed up to Laurel.

All in all a good months submissions all
appearing fine at the Kingdom level and being
forwarded to Laurel level for final approval.
Good luck unto all submitters and we look
forward to hearing good news on all items.
