Ealdormere Letter Of Intent
20 April 2003

Unto Francois la Flamme, Laurel King of Arms and the members of the College of Arms from Percival de la Rocque, Green Mantle Herald, Nele Ap Llewellyn, Seeblatt Herald and the Ealdormere College of heralds.

Greetings Lords and Ladies and good wishes unto you all. It is the intention of the Kingdom of Ealdormere to register the following items.

1. Alistair Kirk (Device Change. Name registered May-83, via Middle)

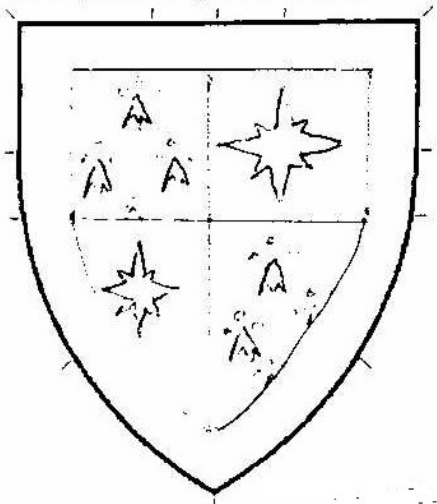
Quarterly argent and ermine azure and Or, in bend sinister two compass stars all within a bordure azure

-wishes current device changed to a badge.

Quarterly ermine and Or, a raven volant sable between in bend sinister two compass stars, all within a bordure azure.

Suggested blazon Quarterly ermine and Or, in bend sinister two compass stars all within a bordure azure.

*The only conflict that we could find for this device was the submitters own device as mentioned above.



2. Auguste Valason (New Name New Badge)

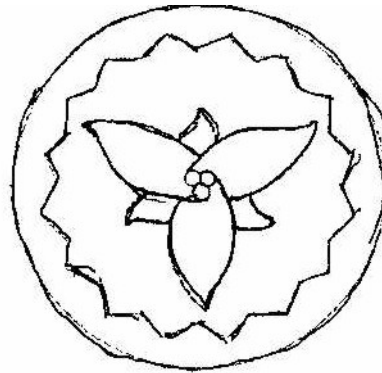
Argent, a trillium gules seeded and barbed vert within a bordure dancetty gules.

-Auguste -pg 16 Dictionnair Etymologique des Noms de Famille et Pronomd de France, Par Albert Dauzat.

-Vali -pg 15 The Old Norse Name, Geirr Bassi Haraldsson. I-A to allow Valason as per pg 17. Use the patronymic of Vali to Valason

-desired gender male, will accept minor changes but care more about sound

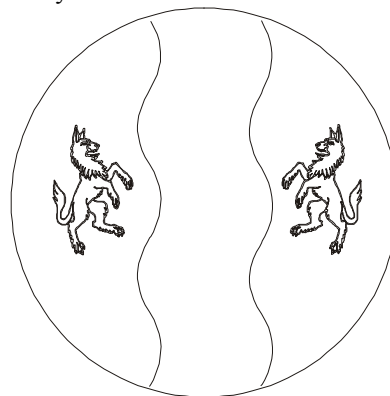
*No conflict could be found and the only negative commentary was based on combination of Old Norse and French names. However we feel this is only one weirdness and as such should be register able. The Badge also does not appear to conflict.



3. Ealdormere, Kingdom of; Scarlet Banner, Award of the (Name Change Oct 1999, Badge Resubmission)

Argent, a pale wavy gules between two combatant wolves sable.

The Order of the Scarlet Banner was passed in October 1999. We wish to fix this since it is really an award.



4. Ealdormere, Kingdom of; Orion, Award of the (Name Change Oct 1999, Badge Transfer)

Purple, an Irish harp, on a bordure Or, five mullets purple

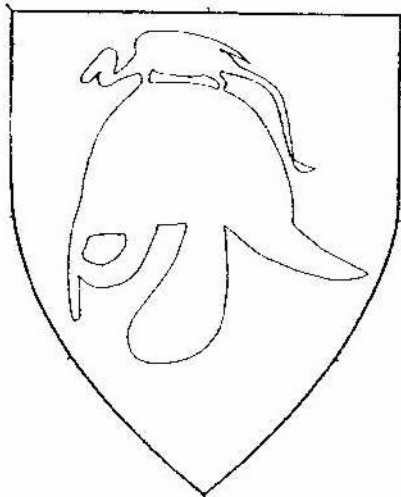
Badge was passed for the Order of Lyra (no currently being used). We wish to transfer to the Award of the Orion, previously passed as the Order of Orion .

*simple paper work changes to items already registered.

5. Gina il Castello del Drago (Name ELOI Nov-02, New Device)

Or, a visored helm crested with a dragon statant purpure.

*While we found the drawings to be somewhat less than perfect we felt this should not cause problem. The blazon is not totally accurate for the style of helm but we will forward this on to be blazoned as needed.



6. Jared Edwardson (New Name, New Device)

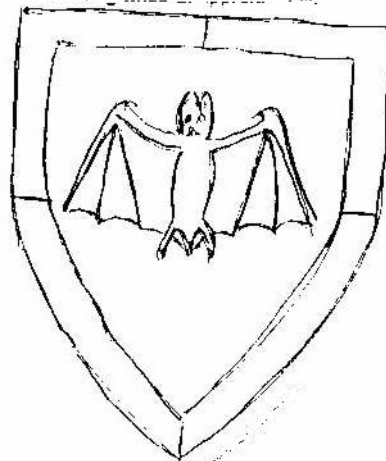
Argent, a bat azure within a bordure quarter azure and sable.

-Jared –given name with attached photocopy of birth certificate

-Edwardson –Reaney & Wilson, Revised Edition 1997, Pg 52.

-desired gender male

*No name conflict found and documentation is in order and satisfactory.. The device does not appear to conflict.



7. Jhone of Woodcote (New Name, New Device)

Lozengy erminois and vert

Jhone –Withicombe pg 176

-Norman French origin of Joan c1200

-Woodcote –typical name construction practices from Anglo Norman lands

-wood for a place near a wooded area and cote from Oxford English Dictionary is shelter

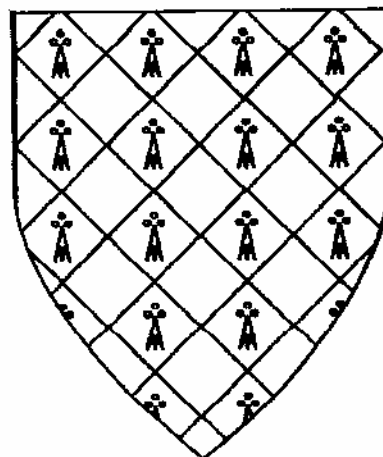
-Similar period constructed names found in Oxford Dictionary of English place Names 1998, AD Mills P388-390

-Woodmancote –Gloucester near Rendcomb 12th century –meaning “cottage of woodmen”

-Woodhouse –S. Yorks C. 1220 “house in woods”

-Submitter wishes a feminine name authentic for 12th C Anglo/Norman and will accept changes.

*No conflict found on name and documentation is in order. Device does not appear to conflict and is very impressive simple heraldry.

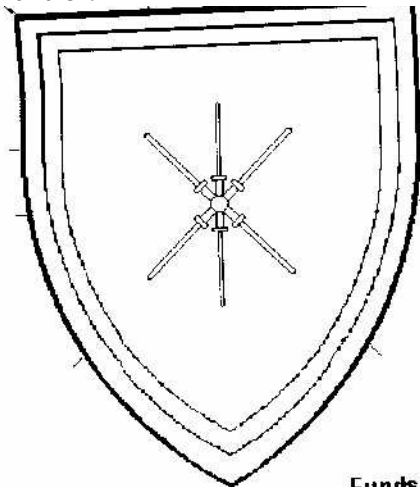


8. Lachlan MacLean (New Name and Device)

Azure, an orle Or, Six Daggers proper conjoined at the hilts.

Lachlan –Scots masculine given name
 -Black p536 under MacLean dates Lachlan McGilleon to 1436.
 MacLean –Scots byname
 -Black p536 under MacLean dates byname spelling MacLein to 1536, “MacCleave” to 1615, MacLane to 1545, M°Cleave to 1615
 -submitter wishes a masculine name authentic for Scottish culture but makes no mention of a time period. He will not accept major or minor changes to the name.

*No conflicts found on the name and all documentation is in order. The Device does not appear to conflict, though we feel the swords need to be drawn bigger and bolder to fill more of the field we will forward this up for a decision. A better blazon in our minds would be Azure six daggers proper conjoined at the hilts an orle Or.

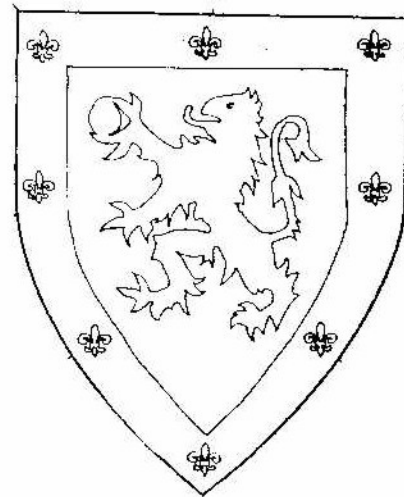
-submitter wishes more about the sound of the name if changes are required and will only accept Min or changes.

*No conflict was found. We do feel the documentation was a little on the weak side but we could see no good reason not to forward this up to Laurel.

11. Richard of Dragon Castle New Device (Name on ELOI Nov 02.)

Purpure, a lion rampant maintaining an egg Or, a bordure Or, semy fleur de lis purpure

We feel a suggested new blazon, Purpure, a lion rampant maintaining an egg, on a bordure Or, a semy de lis purpure. Better reflects the device as drawn. No conflict could be found.



These are the submissions for this letter, There are 6 new devices, 5 new names, 1 new badge, 1 badge resubmission, 2 name changes and 1 badge transfer in total. We hope that all is found in order and all may find acceptance and registration.
