1. Iohannis Fabrizio (Name resubmission, New Device)

Per chevron inverted argent and sable, an arch fracted upon a bar fracted counter charged

Iohannis –Petrus Iohannis Olivi born 1247-1248

-French given name

-URL

-Olivi was a French scholar noted for his commentary on the Apocalypse

-Fabrizio –Don Fabrizio Carafa, Duke of Andria

-no date in particular for this name but in reference to Don Carlo Gesualdo dated 1561-1613

Suggested new blazon, Per chevron inverted argent and sable, a bow fracted counter changed.

2. Jhone of Woodcote (New Name, New Device)

Lozengy erminois and vert

Jhone –Withicombe pg 176

-Norman French origin of Joan c1200

-Woodcote –typical name construction practices from Anglo Norman lands

-wood for a place near a wooded area and cote from Oxford English Dictionary is shelter

-Similar period constructed names found in Oxford Dictionary of English place Names 1998, AD Mills P388-390

-Woodmancote –Gloucester near Rendcomb 12th century –meaning “cottage of woodmen”

-Woodhouse –S. Yorks C. 1220 “house in woods”

3. Kingdom of Ealdormere, Scarlet Banner, Award of the (Name Change Oct 1999, Badge Resubmission)

Argent, a pale wavy gules between two combant wolves sable.

The Order of the Scarlet Banner was passed in October 1999. We wish to fix this since it is really an award.

4. Kingdom of Ealdormere, Orion Award of the (Name Change Oct 1999, Badge Transfer)

Purple, an Irish harp, on a bordure Or, five mullet purple

Badge was passed for the Order of Lyra (no currently being used). We wish to transfer to the Award of the Orion previous passed as the Order of Orion .

5. Lachlan MacLean (New Name, New Device)

Azure, an orle Or, Six Daggers proper conjoined at the hilts.

Not sure of blazon. Is there a “proper” dagger? Pended from previous month omission of name documentation.

Lachlan –Scots masculine given name

-Black p536 under MacLean dates Lachlan McGilleon to 1436.

MacLean –Scots byname

-Black p536 under MacLean dates byname spelling MacLein to 1536, “MacCleave” to 1615, MacLane to 1545, M^cCleave to 1615

-submitter will not accepted major or minor changes to the name.

6. Marioun Golightly (New Name, New Device)

Barry Or and azure, on a bend sable, three escallops argent

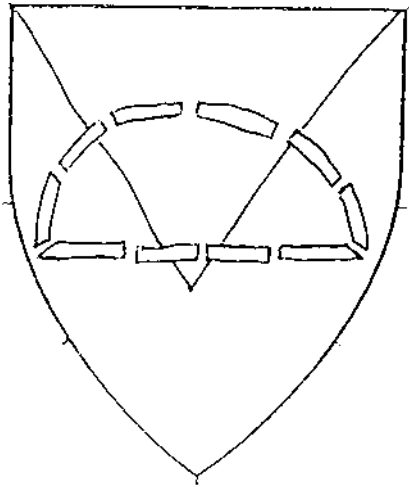
